Spotlight on Drama

Our long-cherished dream came true at last. Waseda Team won the 26th Four University Theatrical Contest held on November 10 and 11, 1962 when it performed R. Brooke's "Lithuania" at the Hitotsubashi Auditorium.

It captured glorious prizes: the Best Coordinate Prize and the Stage Effect Prize, while the three players got the Best Individual Acting Prize, the First and the Third Acting Prizes.

Since the Four University E.S.S. Association held its first Theatrical Contest in 1930, Waseda has never tasted victory until this year, though it was awarded the Stage Effect Prizes and some of the Individual Acting Prizes during the last three years.

It is noteworthy that our performance was appreciated by a large number of people throughout the country on television in the evening of November 27, 1962.

It is true that our play turned out successful in the contest due to the cooperation and understanding among the mem-

bers of this society—not only among those who took part in the drama activity but also among those who didn't. The total of staff members, who dedicated themselves so enthusiastically to the activity, amounted to over 120, which covers about 20 per cent of the members of the E.S.S.

Taking the above-mentioned fact into account, it can not be denied that our drama activity has given some influences, both welcomed ones and unwelcomed ones, upon the E.S.S. This problem can not be paid too much attention in managing this society.
