the relation between a boy and his dog is filled with love, faith and reliance without words, so it is hard to say that there is no conversation.

Well what is "conversation" in our daily life and in our club activities? If we can't feel humanity and personality through conversation, what an irritating, troublesome and worthless thing it is! "Conversation" must be a conduct based on personalities.

This year we, the Cultural Federation Section of W.E.S.S. published "the TARGET," as an initial trial since our Section was established. With this new publication, we considered and discussed what is the substance of our club activities, what attitude we should take as university students, what the present situation is of the world in which we live, and our way of thinking. These things were apt to be covered in the activities of our daily life. Many of you have written to us about the pleasures you had found through your activities as well as disappointments. Through these discussions, we could create substantial activity in our E.S.S.

We strived to make "the TARGET" an informative guide as if it were a light house which flashes over the dark sea for many ships and an old teacher who teaches us our way of living.
